God in Love Unites Us Circuit Conversations The Methodist Church in Britain is in the process of consulting on changes to our current understandings of marriage and relationships. Votes will not be taken at church or circuit level, but we want our district representatives to hear the prayerful voices of local Methodist Christians before attending District Synod. We are hosting 4 conversations around the circuit. These are to enable people to talk through the issues addressed in the report using the God in Love Unites Us study guide.
