HELPING TRINITY Volunteers needed! Are you able to spare a few hours a month (or less) to help out at Trinity? We know how busy everyone is but there are a number of vacancies for key roles in church most of which just take a short time on a Sunday or a couple of hours each month. We are a friendly, flexible church so there's every opportunity to undertake the role in your own way, in your own time. Would you feel able to be:

* **a communion steward** – that's learning how to set up for communion and clear away afterwards – this would be 3 or 4 times a year and full training can be given.

* **the door steward co-ordinator** – that's putting together the rota of door stewards who meet and greet on Sundays – it just takes a couple of hours each quarter. You don't need to be on the rota to undertake this role but it might help if you were.

* **the pastoral secretary** – keeping details of our pastoral groups and ensuring that Ben and Clair are supported in this important aspect of church life. Training and support can be given and this is a real opportunity to take forward our pastoral arrangements as part of a team.

* **Treasurer** – this important role involves two aspects of financial governance – maintaining an effective financial record of church money matters and the day to day financial management of the church. We appreciate this can look daunting so if you are interested, we'd welcome a chat about how much of the role might be undertaken by one person as it's possible that some elements could be provided externally.

* **a church steward** – the stewards work on a rota to support the person leading worship each Sunday. As well as our worship arrangements, they are also responsible for helping us to "be church" by supporting our spiritual well being and practical church matters too. The time commitment is for a few hours every month – but we can be flexible about how this is done – we even have a job share role at the moment.

Our church life only works effectively if members of the church family contribute their talents and time. The Trinity family really needs help – so if you could get involved we'd be so grateful. Please have a chat with Ben, Clair or any of the stewards if you would like to find out more about these roles – or if you feel you can help in other ways which might free someone up to undertake another role.
