The John Batchelor Christian Impact Award In memory of the late John Batchelor a long-standing member at Trinity and using some of the bequest he left to the church we have created the The John Batchelor Christian Impact Award. This is an annual award scheme and is open to all young people across the circuit who are currently in years 7-11. The award scheme seeks to reward a young person's impact on the lives of others with particular note to how this connects to their faith. The scheme panel is aware that the level of impact and what is achieved may be different for different young people. Anyone can nominate a young person and forms are available from the Circuit Office. Examples of impact could be helping out with coffee or the technology at church or being involved in helping to run a Christian Union at their school. The list is endless but it is also something which could be put on future CVs. The top prize is a £50 voucher and there will be some 'Highly Commended' awards each year.
